# **Important Term Dates**

# **Extended Day School Clubs**

Our Early Risers (Breakfast) club and Tea Timers club will commence from

Monday 7th September.

Early Risers Club has two designated arrival times, **8.00am** and **8.30am**. An Early Risers team member will greet children at these times at the main gate. At these times children will be escorted into the building. If you arrive after 8.30am then your child will not be able to enter the building until the start of the school day for their class.

If you are collecting your child from Tea Timers, please enter the school courtyard and ring the doorbell when you arrive. Please note that all children should be collected from our Tea Timers by 5.45pm. If you are running late for collection please call the school office. If you are more than 10 minutes late you will be charged a late collection fee of £10.00 for every 15 minutes. This fee covers the cost of extra time the Tea Timers staff have had to work.

# Wellies and Raincoats.

Please ensure that your child has a spare pair of wellies which can be

left at school. As part of our Montessori teaching the children will often take their

learning outside and the children will participate in their 'Out and About' sessions. Please ensure your child has a raincoat and or a full rainsuit.

# **Drop off etiquette**

We ask that parents do not have lengthy conversations at morning drop off with their class teacher. You will be politely asked to stand away from the gate and a member of the office will be called to speak with you only on matters that need passing to the teachers so that they can be actioned. It may be more practical to email the school prior to drop off and the office staff will pass this on to your child's teacher.

## **Notice Period**

Please be reminded that if your child is not returning in January 2021. then written notice to the school office should be received no later than this Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020. If you have already provided notice, then an acknowledgement letter will be sent home with your child in due course. Notices received after this time, as per your terms and conditions, will mean that Spring term school fees would be due and you would automatically be invoiced accordingly.

# **'Bumped Head' Text**

If your child bumps any part of their head during a school day we will always send a standard text to you. These texts are sent as an extra precaution to ensure you are aware. If you receive a text it is because all is well with your child and we will be keeping an extra eye on them.

#### **No Nuts**

As I'm sure you are all aware we are a strict no nut school; so please ensure that you do not send your child in with nuts or nut based



products in their packed lunch such as small sweets (e.g. snickers) or nut based spreads (e.g. Nutella, peanut butter). We have children in both schools with severe nut allergies. These items will need to be removed from your child's lunch.



## No grapes

Please ensure that you do NOT give your child grapes in their packed

lunch, as young children can easily choke on grapes.

# **Class Information**

#### **Prep Class**

Hello and welcome back to school! We are so pleased to have the children back in the classroom. It's going to be a fun and exciting year!! We are looking forward to our first week of school.

We have lots fun and exciting projects planned for the term.

Our topic for the autumn term will be "maps and seas". We will start by focusing on the sea. We will look at the seas that pirates travelled as well as locating seas around the world. "Treasure island" maps - invent and record physical features using symbols and a key, map co-ordinates and reading a map for a treasure hunt.

## Kindergarten

It was lovely to welcome the children back to Sycamore class and they were all keen to start work. Our topic for this term is autumn. We have already talked about and named the four seasons.

During our art lesson on Friday the children made our display board of an autumn tree. The class enjoyed mixing the colours of Autumn with cotton buds to create the leaves.



#### **Nursery**

We are wishing the Nursery children a warm welcome back and a very smooth start for all the new children joining us this term.

We have an exciting term ahead of us. We are going to celebrate seasons and festivals acknowledging various multicultural celebrations such as Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas. We will look at characteristics of autumn, changes in weather and nature and celebrate harvest. The topic will be supported with many books, art, and science experiments and nature exploration.

This week, we are going to focus on grace and courtesy lessons, getting familiarised with the principals of our environment. We are going to learn how to walk in the classroom, how to carry a chair, how to walk around a floor mat, tidy away our work and how to watch a friend when working.
