Snow Procedure

Can we remind you please that if we do have significant snowfall either this week or in the future, and you are wondering whether the school is open or not, the following procedure would apply:



A Parent Text will be sent before 8.00am. We would only find it necessary to close the school if the snowfall prevents the staff from getting to school, or we feel that it would be unsafe for the children. A decision is usually made before 8am and as such a parent text will be sent out to all parents. We are able to do this remotely.

We are unable to respond to individual messages or enquiries out of school hours, so this system has been devised so that all parents are informed as early as possible. If you do not receive a parent text message then the school is OPEN.

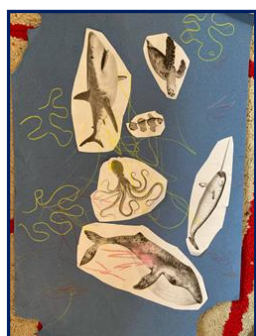

Children's Mental Health

As part of Children's Mental Health Week, we have been engaging with the children through various activities, discussing the importance of being able to express yourself and the different emotions we all feel.



The children took part in some yoga and relaxation exercises and also a kindness activity.



Pop Up House

In Sycamore Class we made a house pop up card. When the card is opened the house comes out (pop ups), out of the background paper.



The children needed to fold the paper and use the scissors. It was fun seeing the children experimenting with the degree the house opened in relation to the card being opened up.

We will be celebrating Chinese New Year on **Tuesday 9th February**. Children will be invited to school wearing red and will be taking part in some fun activities to celebrate the year of the Ox!

Class Information

Prep Class

Prep class children were very busy last week learning about different topics and subjects. One of the topics we are learning about in science is plants. This week, the children will be observing through an experiment the importance of watering the plants regularly and the correct amount, and how too much water can be as bad as too little water.

The children were eager to learn more about this fact, so I thought it would be a good idea to ask your child to look after a plant and record their findings. But what are the skills children learn from nature and how does gardening help



and more; Growing the love of nature: putting love in

what they grow; Teamwork: friends or family and Math: counting days, measuring nutrition, light exposure and more.

We have also been learning about China and the Great Wall, and Prep class children have done amazing work to get their projects done. The children can also remember facts about previous landmarks and want to visit them in person they say!

Sycamore class have been learning about different subjects. The children started the week by taking part in an experiment relating to the Oceans. Oak Class

Last week we discussed the sea and which creatures we can find in the sea.

We practised how to create small and big waves and how to cut a fish shape.

We also played a matching various sea creatures game. We learned different vocabulary, such as octopus, squid and a starfish, and a very popular activity was 'Finley Fish problem-solving'. The children learnt about capacity, compared quantities and objects and how to solve problems.

Also, Oak class children challenged themselves to move like different sea creatures in a range of ways like slithering, jumping, running, rolling and skipping.



At the end of the week, we talked about the importance of self-care. We made a lot of activities to express our feelings; learning how to control our emotions and what can we do to take care of our own mental health.

The children also played a memory game about feelings; creating a glitter jar, made a breathing buddy; and did some Yoga.

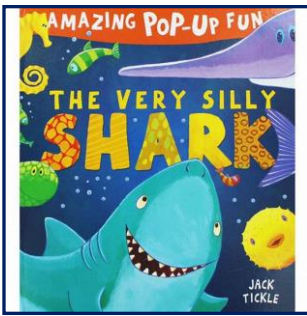


We have also introduced letter "f" for fire and we also tried to think of other words beginning with the sound "f".
