Last week at WMS was Road Safety Week.

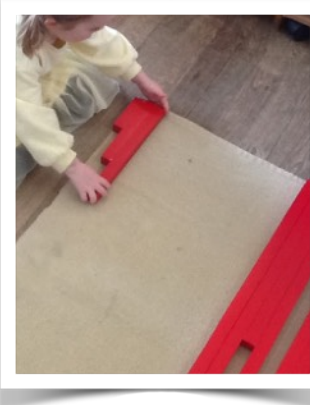
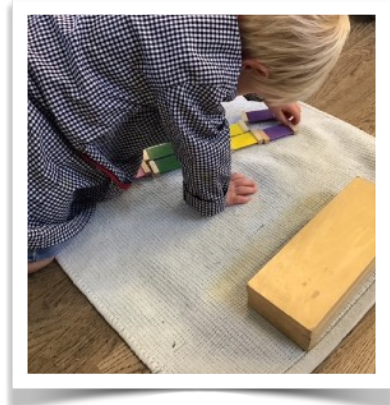
