Are you having a clear out? We would welcome donations of Dressing Up Clothes in good, clean condition. Thank you!



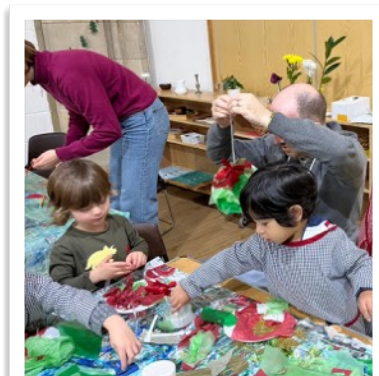
Last week at WMS was very festive! 🎄
