Last week at WMS.

The children enjoyed a sensory mark making activity with shaving cream, glitter and sticks. They used torches and colour reflectors to explore how shadows look in different lights.

The youngest children worked on their cutting skills; they also matched colours and learned about sizes. They baked their own pizzas, making the dough and topping the pizzas with tomato puree and cheese. The older children made vegan cupcakes.

The children also chatted about 'p', the sound the of the week, exploring objects starting with 'p' and painting lots of them with pink paint!

The older children_experimented with shaving foam and pipettes full of blue water to understand what happens when rain clouds are full and produce rain. They all chatted about predicting the weather of the day and the meaning of the word 'meteorology'.

The children at Brookscroft also had lots of fun sketching their own Joan Miro inspired portraits, exploring shapes and colours.


Book of The Week.
