Last week of term.

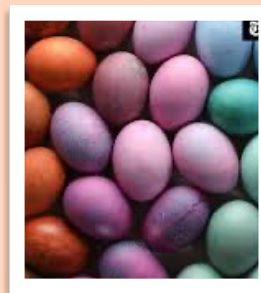
We are breaking up for Easter on Friday and all the children will need to be picked up at 12.30pm.

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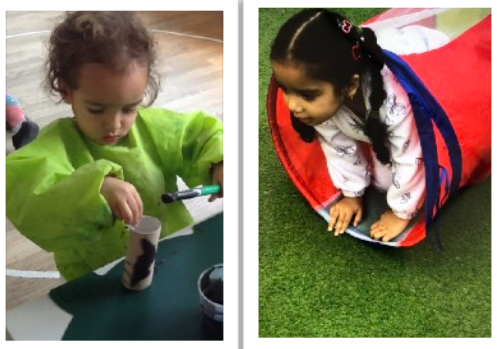
EASTER CLUB

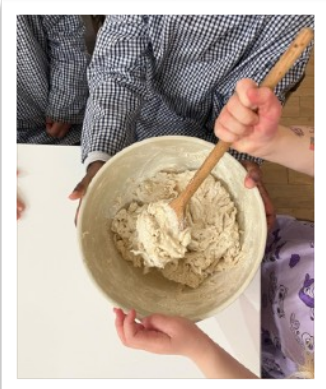
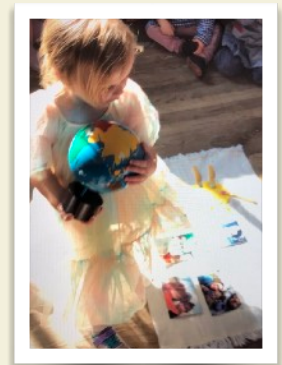
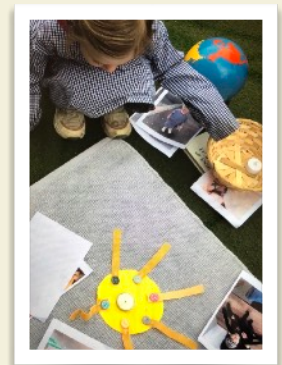
