## Summer Break.

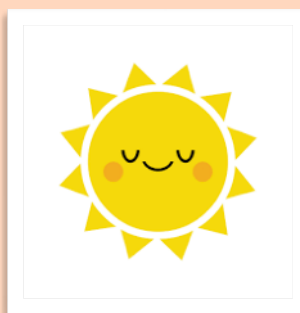

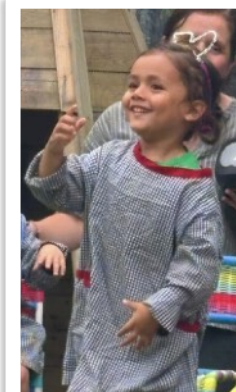
### REPORTS

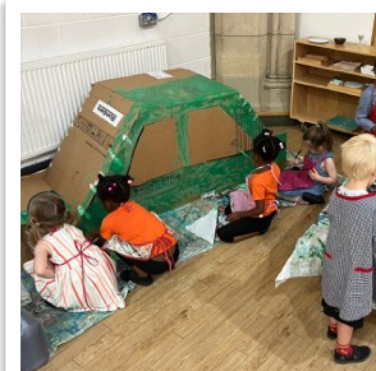
