

Last week at WMS.

We began the week learning about Ramadan and making some Eid cards.

Our topic focus was Australasia. We found it on our Montessori globes and explored its landscape, people and unique animals, discovering that kangaroos live only in Australia. The children created Sydney Opera House and boomerang collages, and also Aboriginal-inspired dot paintings; Elm and Oak classes enjoyed a lesson about Australasia in the garden altogether.

At snack time, the children independently served their pancakes using tongs, squeezed their own lemon juice, cut some soft fruit and practised pouring water from little jugs.

In phonics, we introduced the sound “d”.

Oak Class explored growing microgreens with chia seeds and are hoping to see them sprout soon.

Our flower monitors were Finley B, Coen and Atticus, and Jude enjoyed his Birthday Walk.

At Children’s House Brookscroft, the children learned about Australasia too, its famous landmarks and Aboriginal culture.

Some of the children there have begun working with large quantities and numbers using the Montessori Golden Bead materials.
