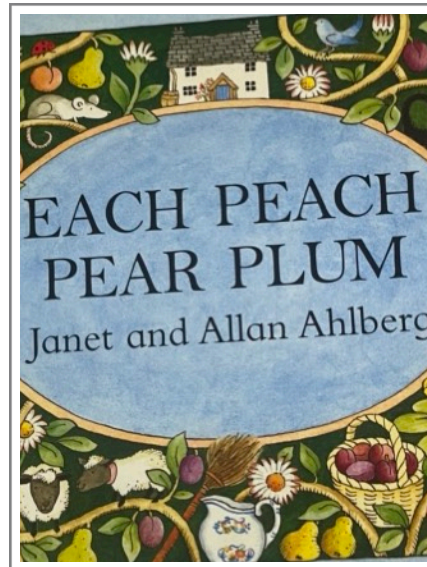

Acorn Class learned about bumble bees, their life cycle and why they are so important. They also explored new geometric shapes using the Montessori Geometric Cabinet.

Seedlings Class explored ice and discovered how it melts into water. They enjoyed water play, learned about the sun and used a thermometer to observe the changing temperature.

Elm Class celebrated Miss Mane's birthday, cooled off with water play, watered the plants and carefully practised their scissor skills.

Oak Class continued learning about bees by building a beehive together, working as a team, and they created beautiful bee artwork for their upcoming concert.

The children at Children's House Brookcroft had lots of fun keeping cool with water and ice play, while continuing their bee topic and making minibeast homes from recycled materials. Their Forest School session was a highlight; they completed exciting water challenges to help Dino the Dinosaur fill his paddling pool and also enjoyed fun worm and caterpillar activities!

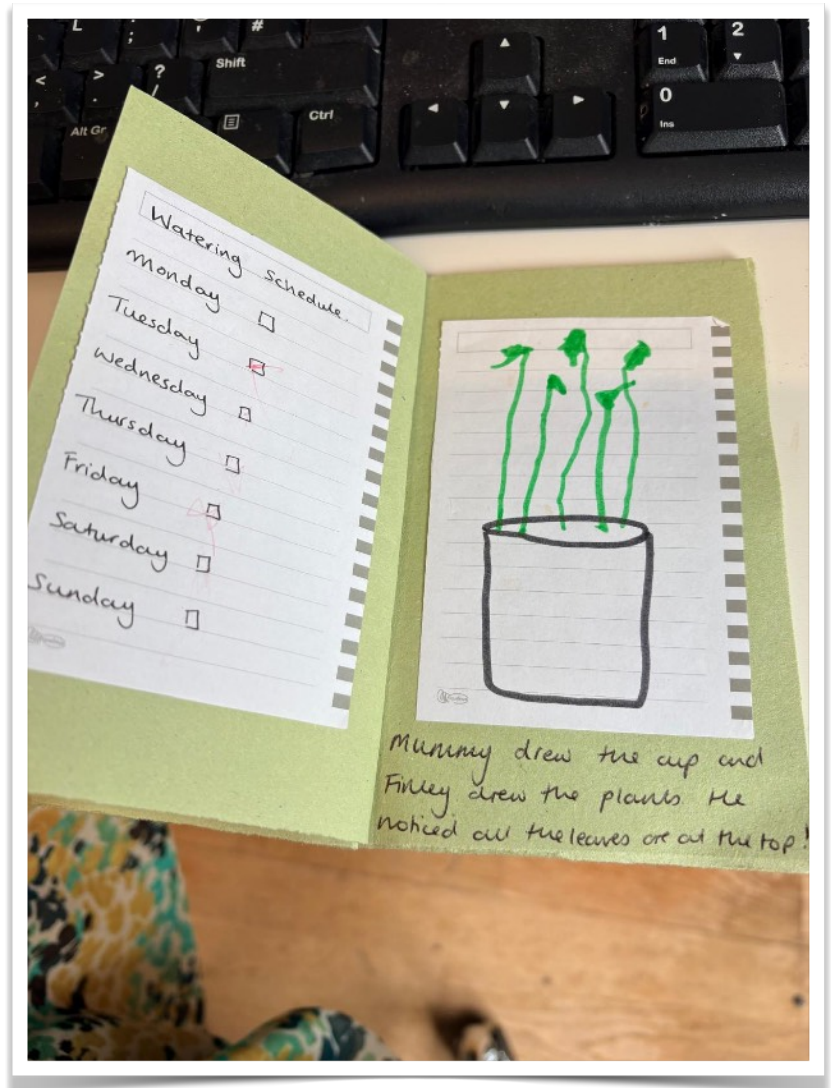
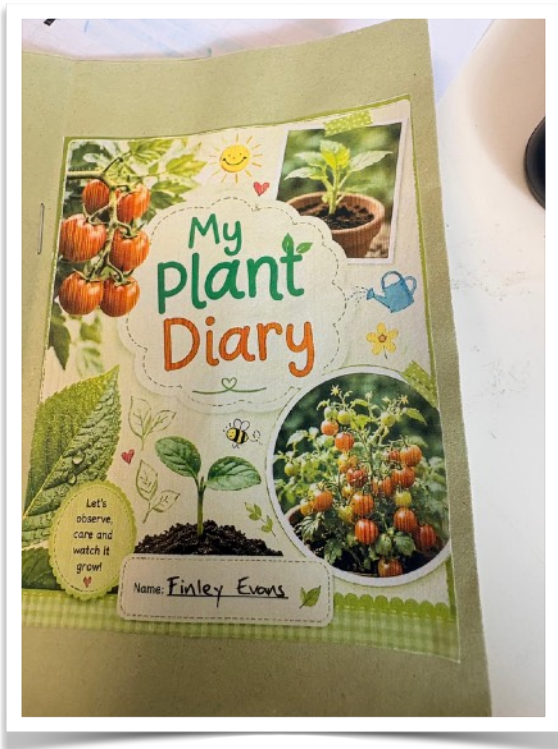
