Elm Class celebrated a fantastic achievement this week as one child successfully practised writing her name unaided. The children also enjoyed sensory exploration and creative activities using shaving foam and paint.

Oak Class learned about the quatrefoil shape, revised the colour brown, and practised counting to 8. They explored the frog life cycle, focused on the sound 'c', and enjoyed making sports medals in preparation for this week!
